CALL FOR AWARDS NOMINATIONS

Lifetime Achievement in Cultural Neuropsychology Award

This award is organized and administered by the Hispanic Neuropsychological Society (HNS) Awards and Fellows Task Force. Nominations of individuals for this award should include a description of how their work impacted the profession of cultural neuropsychology, including their scientific and/or scholarly publication achievements, teaching or training programs, advocacy, and contributions to HNS.

The Awards and Fellows Task Force shall establish the finalists for the Lifetime Achievement in Cultural Neuropsychology Award after considering all neuropsychologists who were nominated. Finalists for the award will be determined by a process whereby each member of the Awards and Fellows Task Force independently reviews each nominee's submission then ranks each nominee based on the nominee's impact on cultural neuropsychology, including their scientific and/or scholarly achievements, teaching or training programs and advocacy.

Procedure:

1. Solicitation:

The award details and nomination process shall be featured on the HNS website, the HNS listserv, during HNS Convention and Meetings, and in other appropriate venues/outlets.

Nominations must be submitted via email HNSAwards@hnps.org and be accompanied by the nominee's CV, summary of the nominee's relevant contributions/qualifications (no more than 500 words), with 2 additional letters of support. Self-nominations will be accepted.

2. Eligibility:

Nominees must be at least 10 years post-doctoral experience and have contributed significantly to the field. Nominees must be/become professional members of HNS.

3. Selection:

The Awards and Fellows Task Force will review the application materials for all nominees, independently ranking them from most favorable to least favorable based on pre-determined scoring criteria. At the next HNS Executive Committee (EC) Meeting the Awards and Fellows Task Force shall propose award finalists (a minimum of 2) to the EC. The EC shall select the awardee for the Lifetime Achievement in Cultural Neuropsychology Award by a majority decision.

4. Schedule of Nomination Activities for the Lifetime Achievement in Cultural Neuropsychology Award

November 30:	Call for Nominations
January 7:	Deadline for Submission of Nominations
January 25:	Preparation of Final Slate (No fewer than two nominees per award)
January:	Vote at next Executive Committee Meeting
February 4:	Notify Nominees of Selection
February/June/October:	Award Presentations at HNS Meeting during HNS Convention
